

2011-2012 TICKETING ARRANGEMENTS

Renewal Fee:

\$140.00 (Inc GST)

Members of the Club will receive:

- 1 Membership Card and Car pass (not transferable)
- 1 Guest Card

The Guest Card will admit the Member's Guest to the Racecourse and the Members' Reserve on all racedays. Members have the option of purchasing a **second Guest Card for \$70.00 (Inc GST) at the time of paying their annual subscription.**

This membership card will allow you access to all 24 of the club's meetings including Jayco Bendigo Cup day, new Premier Saturday meeting 17 March 2012, weekdays, weekends and public holiday meetings along with Elmore Cup day and Marong Cup day, plus any other transferred meetings that the Bendigo Jockey Club may receive throughout the season.

Loyalty Rewards: The club is investigating establishing member discount arrangements on selected Sponsors venues/products.

New Members: Members are asked to encourage new Members to join the Bendigo Jockey Club. Nominations for Membership forms are available from the Secretary's Office or online at www.bendigo.countrysiding.com.au

Additional Members Benefits: Members of the Bendigo Jockey Club will receive periodic Members Newsletter. Members also have the option to book private functions at discounted rates. Reduced pricing is offered for members to all club events and corporate marquees. Members only marquee 's are offered in the Palms Precinct. Jayco Bendigo Cup day and possibly at other feature meetings.

Wearing of Cards / Tickets: The Member's Card and Guest Card must be worn so as to be plainly visible to Club staff at all times while the ticket holder is within the Members' Reserve. It is the responsibility of the Member to ensure that there is no misuse of any tickets issued.

Standard of Dress: Members and guests are asked to adhere to the following regulations. Minimum dress standards in the Members' enclosure:

Males: Gentlemen are expected to maintain a suitable dress standard in keeping with the dignity of the Member's Reserve which includes collared shirts, suit jacket or sports coat, tailored shorts and slacks with appropriate sandals will be acceptable.

Not Acceptable:

- Thongs, dilapidated footwear, scuffs or slippers.
- Singlets
- Beanies
- Football Guernsey's

Females: Ladies are expected to maintain a suitable standard in keeping with the dignity of the Members Reserve which includes tailored slacks, skirts, dresses and tailored ¾ pants.

Not Acceptable:

- Thongs (unless dress thongs)
- Dilapidated footwear, scuffs, uggs or moccasins.
- Tracksuits

Please note: A higher standard of dress is required on Jayco Bendigo Cup day and Premier Saturday. Refer to club's website.

Non Smoking Venue: All indoor areas at the racecourse are smoke free.

Alcohol: Alcohol is not permitted to be brought onto the racecourse in accordance with the club's liquor license. Beverages are available for purchase at several outlets on course.

On each raceday, the Silks Dining Room offers an a-la-carte menu and an afternoon tea service, plus full bar and tote facilities. Members' can dine in comfort overlooking the track.

2. Metropolitan Membership Privileges

Reciprocal Rights are also available at mid-week non-holiday meetings and on Sundays at the V.R.C., the M.R.V.C. and V.A.T.C.

In addition, the Members' privileges are available for the following special meetings:

Note: Members must produce their card when they make application for reciprocal rights at the Office of the relevant Club.

3. Overseas Racing Clubs

Members visiting overseas may apply to the Secretary's Office for a letter of introduction to overseas Racing Clubs.

4. Bendigo Harness Racing Club

On presentation of the membership card, Bendigo Jockey Club members will be admitted free to all meetings at Lords Raceway Junortoun – except for the Bendigo Pacing Cup meeting, when normal admission charges will apply.

Please note: Reciprocal Rights do not apply on Bendigo Cup day and Premier Saturday or at any of the above Clubs on their Cup Days.

*Please note that patrons are not permitted to bring in their own shade canopies or umbrellas, although chairs and fold out tables are allowed in public areas only.

Cup Day Visitors' Tickets: Should members wish to purchase additional tickets for guests on Cup day, tickets can be purchased for \$85 (Inc GST) which entitles the bearer to admission to the Racecourse and Members Reserve. General Admission tickets to the Public areas within the race course are available for \$25.00 (Inc GST)

Silks Dining Room: Please note bookings are essential for the Silks dining room to avoid disappointment. Offering a three course luncheon plus afternoon tea served to your table and a reserved seat all day with panoramic views of the magnificent Bendigo Racecourse. Cost is \$165.00 (Inc GST) per head, and booking can only be made by current financial Members of the Bendigo Jockey Club. **Please note the charge for non members attending the Silks Dining Room is \$250.00 which includes general admission and members cross over.**

Members Only Marquee 'Palms Precinct' located in the Corporate Village: Preference is given to bona fide members of the Bendigo Jockey Club in this area which is situated in a prime location under the magnificent Palms in the Luxbet Corporate Village area. This package includes a 3m x 3m Marquee, 1x 1.8m trestle table, 2x 1.5m round table and 20 chairs. 30 armbands for entry into this area will be allocated to each site. Cost per site is \$500.00. Please note that no additional furniture will be permitted to be brought into this area. A cash bar or pre-ordered beverage package is available.

Members Enclosure: Owing to the size of the viewing area in the Members' Enclosure, tables and chairs are not permitted to be set up on Bendigo Cup Day in this Enclosure.
